A303 Accidents (July 3rd to August 8th 2008)

Thurs July 3rd

A343 - A303 Junction Salisbury Road

Motorcyclist lost control of his vehicle: A303 ground to a halt whilst emergency vehicles attended.

Tues July 8th

A303 - 100 Acre Roundabout

Broken Down Lorry: All roads around Andover blocked as a result.

Frid July 11th

A303 - Thruxton

Car collided with central reservation: Westbound carriageway at a standstill for sometime.

Sun July 13th

A303 - Barton Stacey

Several emergency vehicles attend to free a horse that had put its foot through side of horsebox: Severe congestion.

Mon July 14th

A303 - Bullington

Broken down lorry: traffic backed up onto A34.

Weds July 16th

A303a.m. - Andover

Winchester road junction closed: Broken down lorry causing tailbacks.

Weds July 16th

A303p.m. - Abbott's Ann Down

Broken down car & trailer causing congestion.

Frid July 18th

A303p.m.

Very slow & congested: sheer weight of traffic.

Mon July 21st

A303p.m. Amesbury/Winterslow/Stoke

Road blocked: alternative route through Ludgershall – very slow also due to roadwork's in that area.

Thurs July 24th

A34/M3 Junction

Serious road traffic accident, several vehicles in attendance:

A303 at a standstill: A34 closed in both directions at Micheldever.

July 25th (Update on above)

2 killed: road closed for 6hrs, plus 2 drivers injured after a collision between 2 vehicles that had been diverted onto the A30 as a result of the above incident. * Aug 7th – One driver from A30 crash dies from injuries*

Fire @ Recycling plant on Thruxton Airfield – Access from A303:

Emergency Services still in attendance 12hrs later.

N.B. Licence granted (By HCC) for gravel extraction @ Longparish with entrance & exit for HGV's onto the A303.
